

Allergies

- All allergies AND reactions to the allergen MUST be provided on enrollment forms.
- MCA will strictly monitor allergies. Please communicate with your child's teacher and the school nurse.
- Life-Threatening Allergies
 - All Epinephrine and life-saving medications will be kept in a locked safe box in the child's classroom.
 - Required documentation to accompany life-saving medication:
 - Anaphylaxis Action Plan, provided by the child's medical provider (for Epinephrine only)
 - Asthma Action Plan, provided by the child's medical provider (for inhalers only)
 - Medication Authorization form, provided by MCA
 - **MCA must have an action plan on file in order to respond quickly and efficiently to emergency situations.**
- Seasonal/Environmental Allergies
 - Please note that if a student is present at MCA, they are expected to participate in all scheduled activities, including outdoor play with their class. MCA recognizes that seasonal and environmental allergies can be challenging; however, students who attend school are required to remain with their class during outdoor play and cannot stay indoors during this time.
